Attendance at this meeting is not required to bid on the future contracts associated with the upcoming airfield reconstruction projects discussed at the meeting.

The following upcoming airfield projects will be discussed:

- **The reconstruction of the Runway 4R/22L (12,000') and associated taxiways at DTW**
- **The reconstruction of portions of Taxiway Whiskey at DTW**
- **The reconstruction of Runway 5R/23L (7,526') at YIP**

Encouraged to attend are contractors interested in submitting bids to the Wayne County Airport Authority and subcontractors and material suppliers interested in participating in bidding on future airfield reconstruction projects. While a company may send its estimator, field superintendants familiar with airfield construction within a fully operational airport are especially encouraged to attend.

What is the purpose of the Informational/Constructability Meeting?

The purpose of this Informational/Constructability Meeting is to:

- present a general overview for each project
- discuss project schedules, access to the work areas, and other items
- identify issues affecting the constructability of the projects
- receive technical questions and input from attendees
- provide a networking opportunity for attendees

Attendees are encouraged to provide input on the items and topics presented and discussed. Information provided during the meeting is non-binding and will not affect any future construction contract or bidding process related to any future Wayne County Airport Authority project.

What type of work is anticipated for these airfield reconstruction projects?

The anticipated construction scope of work for these projects includes labor, equipment, materials, and supplies associated with:

- site grading
- asphalt and concrete pavement removal
- excavation
- drainage structures and systems
- sub grade preparation
- aggregate placement

- asphalt leveling and porous base paving
- Portland cement concrete paving
- asphalt shoulder paving
- grading and site restoration
- pavement markings
- runway and taxiway centerline and edge lighting
- airfield signage
- airfield electrical systems and components
- navigation aids which may include ILS, RVR, PAPI
- quality control, testing, and surveying
- other miscellaneous items required to complete the projects
